White Amur (grass carp)	Minnow family member; stocked for vegetation control; will not spawn, average life expectancy seems to be 10-12 years	8- 10 inches	\$16.00		
Japanese Koi	Colorful, will eat vegetation such as duckweed and watermeal; stocking rate max - 5 koi per acre	5-7 inches	\$13.00		
Largemouth Bass	Popular with anglers; typical weight 2-3 lbs. can reach 5-6 lbs.	2-3 inches	\$1.30		
Bluegill	"Catchable" for kids; needs predator fish stocked for management	2-4 inches	\$1.00		
Hybrid Bluegill	Known for faster growth; a prey item of largemouth bass; a cross between a male bluegill and female green sunfish; seem to be easy to catch.	2-4 inches	\$1.00		
Shell cracker (red-ear sunfish)	Eat snails and small mollusks; spawns once a year; should be stocked in addition to forage fish	2-4 inches	\$1.00

 GENERAL TRANSPORT RECOMMENDATION: ONE CONTAINER PER 100 FINGERLINGS, ONE CONTAINER PER 1,000 MINNOWS, ONE CONTAINER FOR 4-5 AMUR OR KOI (5 GALLON BUCKETS WORK WELL BUT PLEASE DO NOT USE THE LID (USE TWINE OR STRING TO CLOSE THE BAG)
