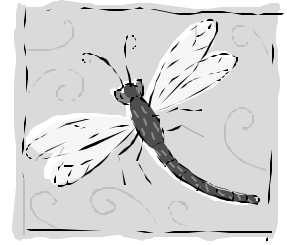

Information Sheet

- Trumbull SWCD's two-day Watershed Field School will run from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. **The drop-off time will be from 9:45 to 10:00 am, and pick-up will be from 3:00 to 3:15 pm.**
- During these two days, children, **ages 9 - 12**, will have the opportunity to experience, small-group, hands-on activities while exploring the interconnectedness of animals, soils, wetlands and forestry within the watershed. Activities will be designed to engage the students in learning while having fun!
- Presenters and instructors will include staff members of Trumbull Soil and Water Conservation District, Penn-Ohio Watershed Association and Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Division of Parks and Recreation.
- A complete schedule, map, health and release forms, and further details will be sent to registered participants approximately 2 weeks prior to the camp dates.
- The **\$25 fee** for campers covers the cost of lunch and snacks each day and the purchase of materials used during the lessons and field trips. **Registration deadline is Friday, June 4th. Please note that space is limited. Register early.**

- Exploring watersheds with site visits to Mosquito State Park and Walnut Run Creek
- Constructing simple tools for observing nature with recycled materials
- Important functions of wetlands for wildlife and water quality
- Land use impacts on streams
- Exploration of fish and wildlife in stream and pond ecosystems
- Water quality testing and macroinvertebrate sampling
- Water cycle fun
- Nature crafts, outdoor games and snacks
